Dear Mr. Anticoli,

We are in receipt of your letter dated 1st February 1951, and thank you for the information supplied regarding your daughter Fiorella and your three nieces.

Tracing action has now been started, the Committee of Liberated Jews in Poland, who hold records on Jewish persons who survived from concentration camps, having been approached by us with the request to check all available records for the name of your daughter Ficrella, who presumably was deported together with her grandmother Mrs. Ficrina Spiszichino on 16.10.1945. We have had photostat copies made of the large photograph of your daughter, which you sent us directly. Also the office of the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organisation in Paris forwarded to us a picture of Fiorella, which we keep in our files for tracing action.

We return herewith the picture which you sent us, as requested, and would assure you of our desire to be of assistance in finding out the fate of little Fiorella.

We shall not fail to keep you up to date as to what information we receive from Foland . We must, however, point out that correspondence with Poland is rather slow, and that we do not expect a reply before several months.
