Further to our letter dated 14.2.1951, we should like to inform you that our I.T.S. Headquarters in Archen, was taken over by the Allied High Commission for Germany on April 1, 1951. As a consequence of this our functions are limited to checking our various indices and records only, and no further tracing ection will be taken by us.

learnt that Italian children of Jewish religion were most often deported to Poland to the concentration camp Auschwitz, as well as to the sub-camp Birkenau. The survivors of these camps were liberated by the Russians in 1945.

According to information to hand, Frof. Kudrisveeff, supervising the concentration camps in the liberated Zone, was in possession of the lists of the survivors. A member of the said Commission, a Frof. Epstein, was living in Frague 16, Fibichova 12.

children were removed by the Russians, to the Crimea in Russia, and placed there in Children's sanatoriums. All our attempts to secure copies of the lists of the survivors for our records, have failed.

was also taken to Ausohwitz, we would advise you to apply to the Italian Foreign Office in this connection, asking their assistance in contacting the Soviet authorities through the Italian Consulate in Moscow.
